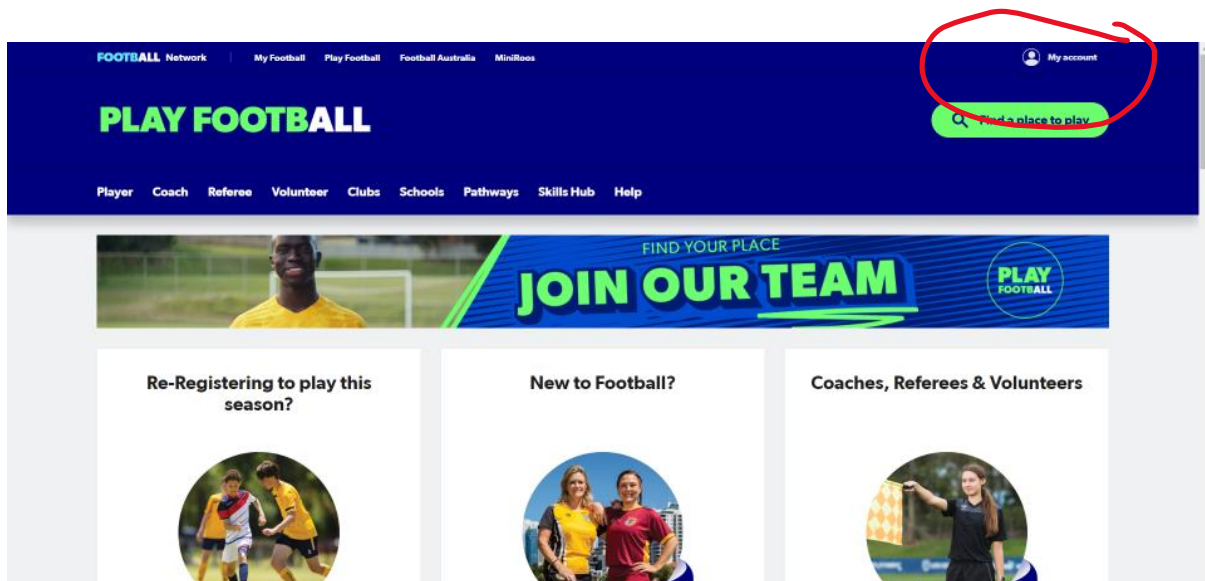
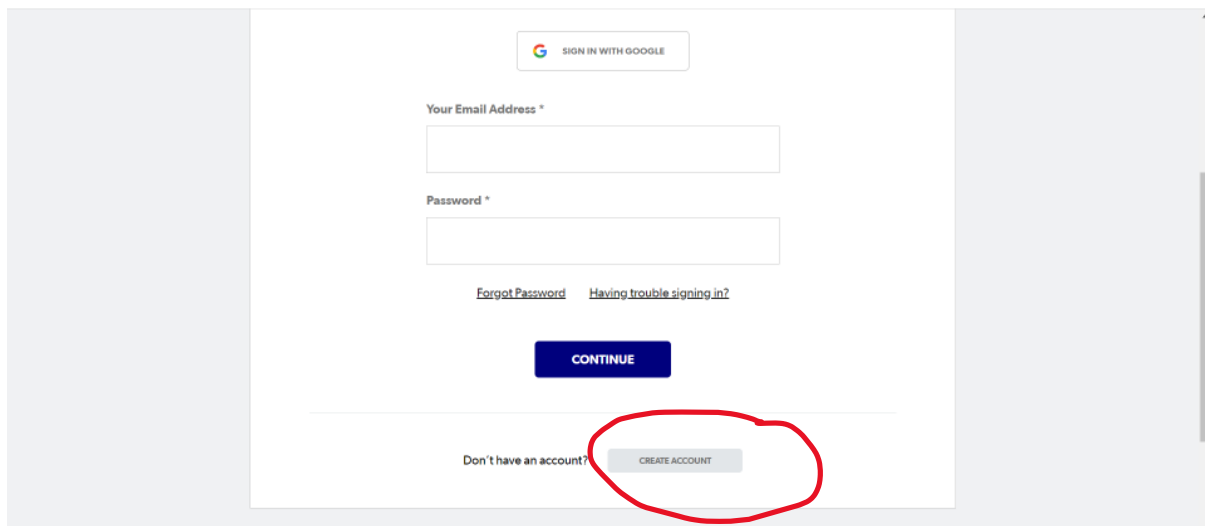

Click on “Create Account”

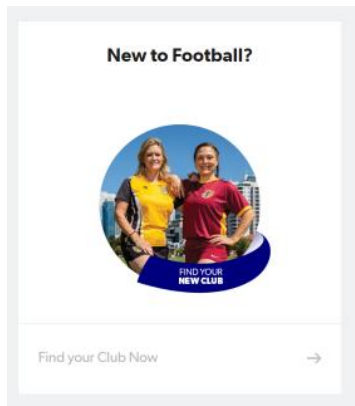


Complete all personal details, Accept terms and conditions, and complete the “I am not a robot” reCAPTCHA then click on “Register”.

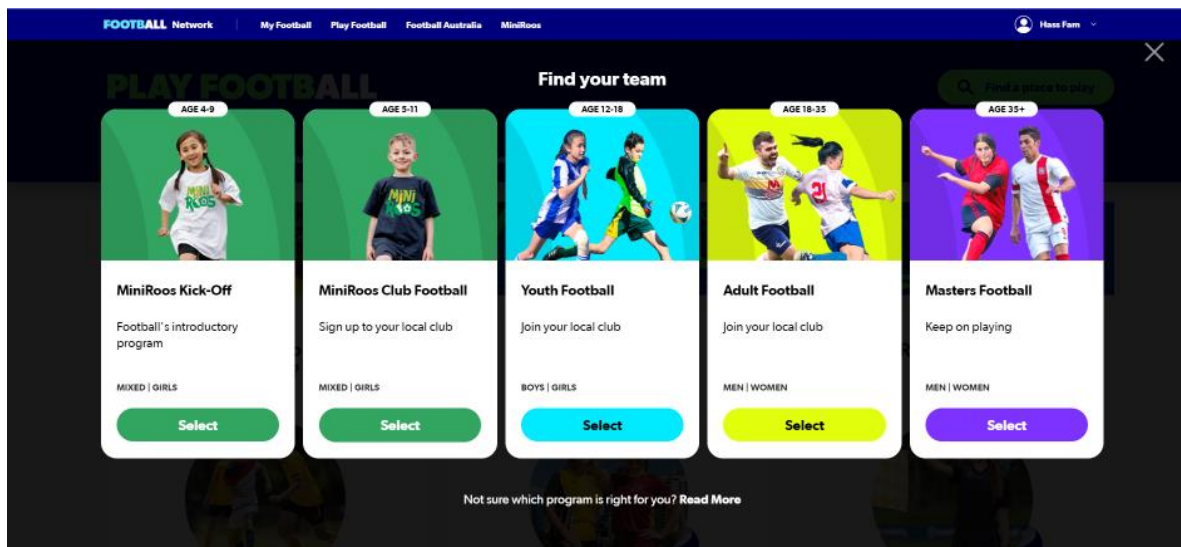
Head to your email inbox and find the verification code.

Enter this code to verify your email. You will then be asked to re-enter your password.

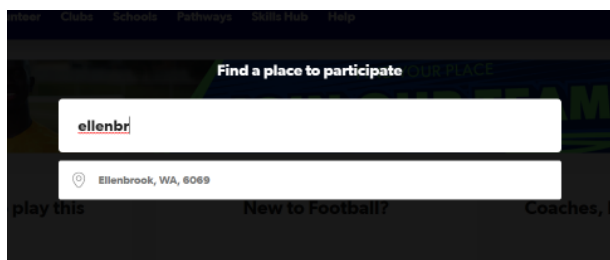
You can now click on “New to football”



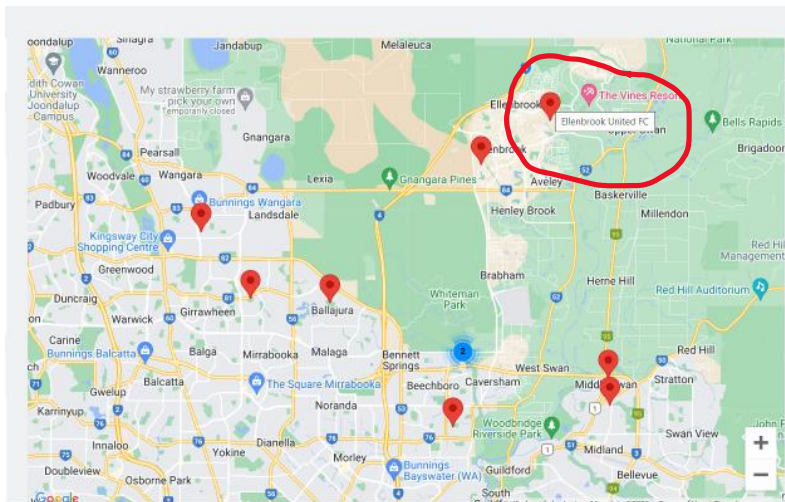
Select the relevant age group:

If you have never registered your details will not be displayed and you can click on “Continue”.

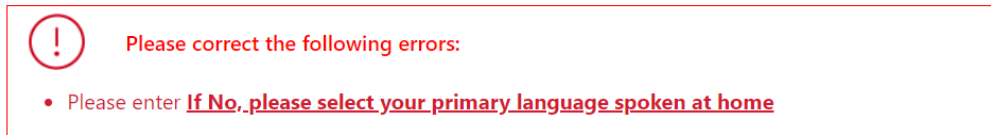
Find the relevant team you want to register for and click “Select”
