Team Muster/Trials:

Saturday October 25th

All players wanting to return to EUFC for 2026 are required to attend the team muster. Registration is essential.

The schedule and more information will be sent out soon to all those who have registered.

If you have a valid reason for not attending please contact registrar@eufc.org.au to let us know you cannot make it and which team you wish to play for next season. We will liaise with coaches and accommodate returning players as best we can.

To secure your place for 2026 and the early bird discount, a non-refundable deposit of \$150 is required. We have 4 options available for this deposit:

- Pay \$50 (card only) at the muster day, and a further \$100 through online invoice (afterpay available) before 15th Nov.
- Pay \$150 (card only) at the muster day.
- Pay in full (card only) at the muster day - see 2026 fees below.
- If using Kidsport - pay \$50 (card only) at the muster day, and provide your Kidsport voucher code before 15th November (see further down in the email regarding Kidsport vouchers).

The remainder of fees will be due around early February with a definite date to be announced once Football West release their 2026 calendar.

2026 Fees:

Club Earlybird Fees (closes 15th Nov):

- Minirosos (U8s-12s): \$300
- Junior Community League (U13s-16s): \$350
- Junior Development League (U13-16s): \$650
- U18s: \$650
- Masters: \$350
- Senior Mens and Womens: TBA

There will be an increase in club fees for all registrations received after 15th Nov 2025.

No payment plans will be offered, however Afterpay is available.

Football West/Football Australia Fees:

These are required to be paid (in addition to club fees) directly through PlayFootball in the new year when you do your Football West registration.

Below are the 2025 fees, as a guide. (2026 fees have not yet been announced).

- 12s & Under: Football West \$68.80, Football Australia \$15
- 13s-16s: Football West \$91.43, Football Australia \$15
- 17s-18s: Football West \$110.28, Football Australia \$15-35
- 19 & over: Football West \$160.83, Football Australia \$35

Please note; these fees are based on the age of the player, not the age group they are playing in.

Volunteer Levy:

As a volunteer run club we are introducing a volunteer levy of \$100 per family for 2026.

Coaches, Team Managers and Committee members are exempt.

All other families who volunteer their time will have their levy refunded.

More information on positions/roles you can volunteer for are detailed in the Season Muster Player Registration form (www.eufc.org.au/season-2026-muster), however, we are open to hearing from our members on ways you believe you can help.

2026 Uniforms:

Uniforms will be done a little differently next year.

Game day shirts in our brand new design (soon to be revealed) will be provided by the club, all other items can be purchased through the club online shop, as needed.

- Training kit: Grey shirt, Grey shorts, Sky blue socks.
- Game day kit: New blue shirt (provided), Sky blue shorts, Black socks.

If you already own these items you do not need to purchase new. Top ups can be purchased through the club online shop. Other merchandise items (eg: hoodies, jackets, beanies, polos etc) will also be available online.

We are working behind the scenes on the club online shop and will notify you when it is ready.

Please note: Game day tops are club property and need to be returned at the end of the season.

Kidsport:

If your child is between 5-18 years old and named on a valid Services Australia Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card, you may be eligible to claim up to \$500 per financial year to go towards sport.

If using this option, you will be required to claim the full \$500. This money will come directly to the club and then we pay your Club fees, Football West/Football Australia fees, Volunteer levy, and we will liaise with you on any uniform top ups required - to the total value of \$500. Anything over \$500 will need to be covered by yourself.

We are looking forward to another exciting year of football at EUFC!
